



However, it has come to the notice of UGC that a number of institutions are offering degrees in contrary to the provision of the UGC Act. Degrees awarded by such universities/institutions shall neither be recognized nor valid for higher education and employment purposes.

Hence, all concerned are requested to check the UGC website: www.ugc.ac.in for information about recognized universities/institutions as well as fake institutions before taking admission in any institution for higher education. Further, if any university/institution is offering academic programmes in contravention of the UGC Act, the same may also be brought to the notice of UGC via email to ugcampc@gmail.com so that appropriate action can be taken against such institutions.
