International Seminar on Issues and Advancement in the Contemporary World

The International Seminar on Issues and Advancement in the Contemporary World (Online mode) was hosted on 5th June 2024 by IQAC, RKMV. The three day international seminar (3rd June to 5th June 2024) was jointly organised by ICFRE-HFRI Shimla, RGGDC Shimla, COE GC Sanjauli, and GGC Hamirpur.

The event had four technical sessions in which the Resource Persons deliberated on the topics of physical and mental well-being: Dr. Vasu Singh “Chronic Pain: Raising Awareness,” Ms. Mikaila Chetty, “Syzygium Cumini and its Traditional Health Benefits,” Dr. Monojit Dass “Life in metro cities: Kolkata and Moscow” and Mr Sohail “Digital Health.”
