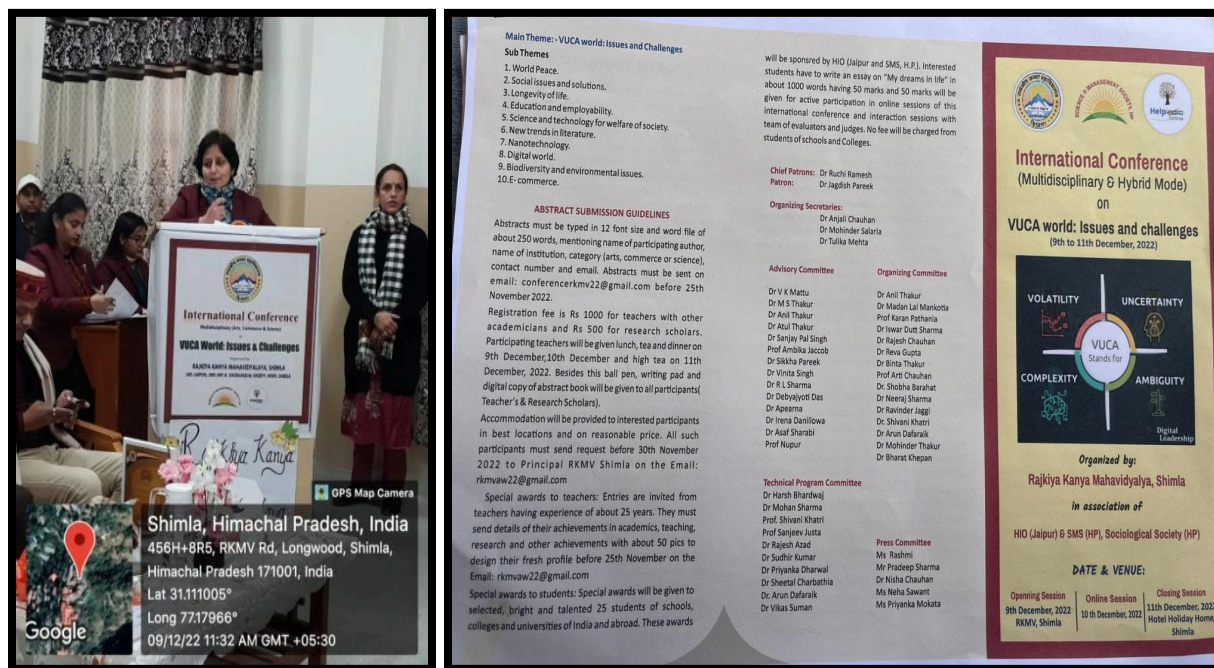


1. VUCA World Conference (9/12/2022-11/12/2022)

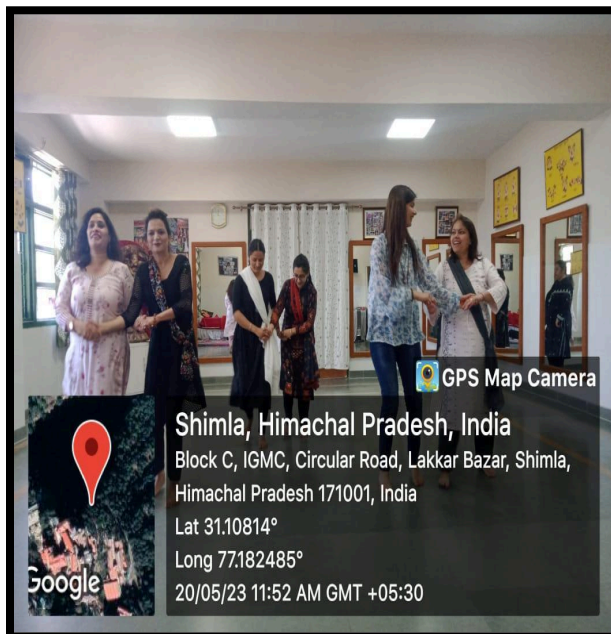

4. Impact of COVID on Indian Economy

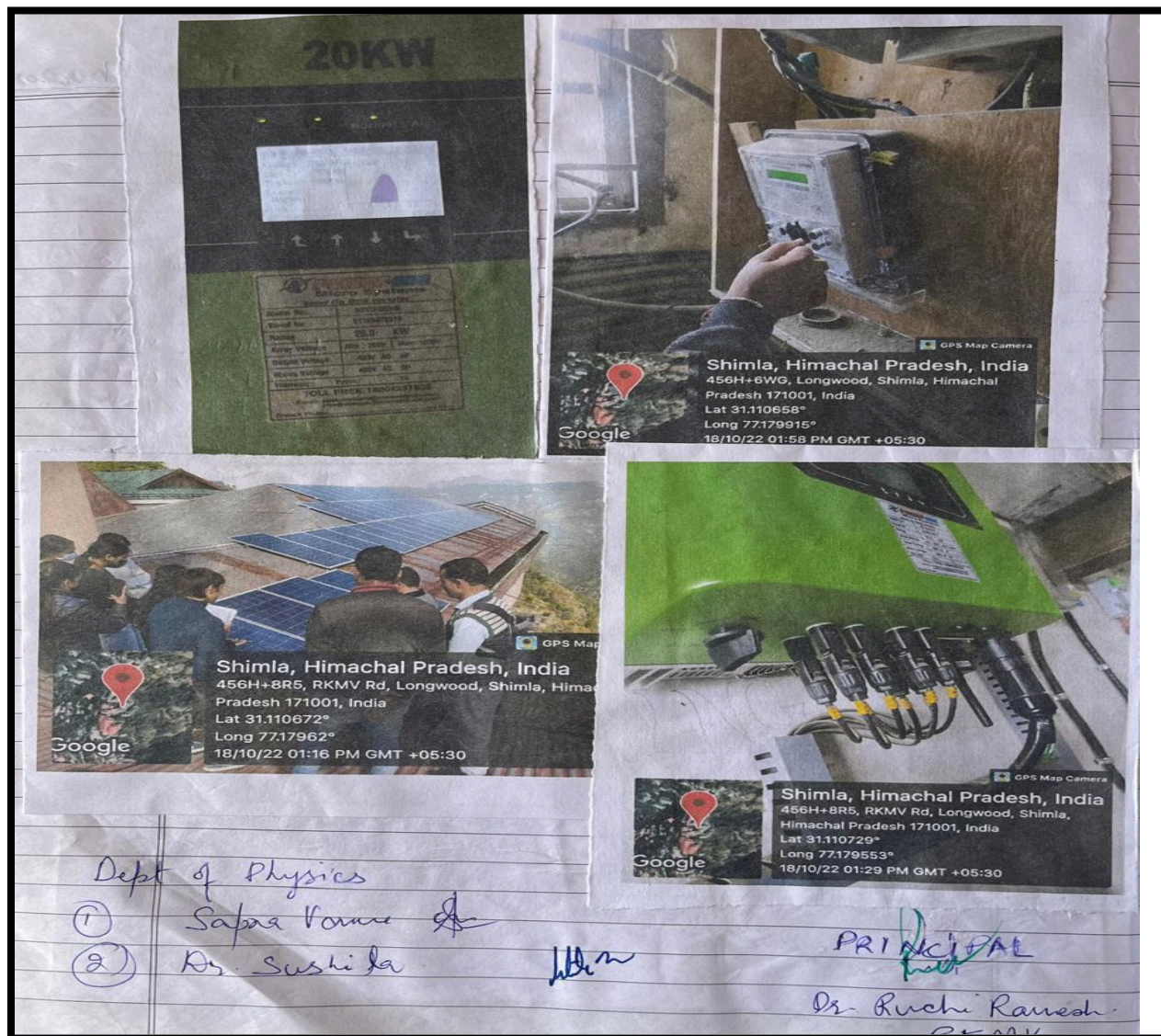

6. Workshop on Molecular Biology and Biotechnological Techniques

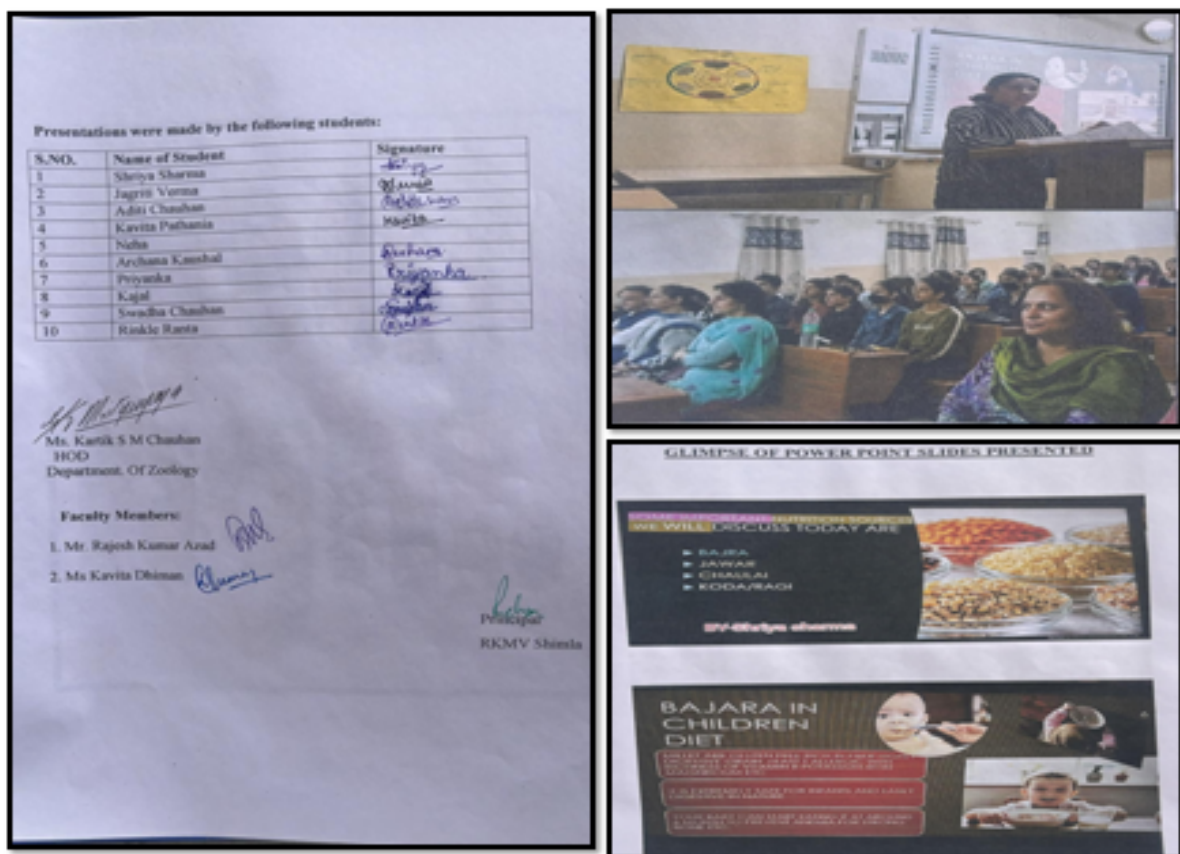

Along with this application of RT-PCR a clinical diagnostic technique was demonstrated for students. Demonstrations were given by Dr. Rahul Shrivastava on Drug discovery, Disk differentiation and Antibiotic sensitive tests. Dr. Ashok Kumar Nadda demonstrated producing cosmetic products, formation of bioplastic and producing Calcium carbonate from atmospheric carbon dioxide. Dr. Hemant Sood demonstrated Plant tissue culture and Hydroponics.
