

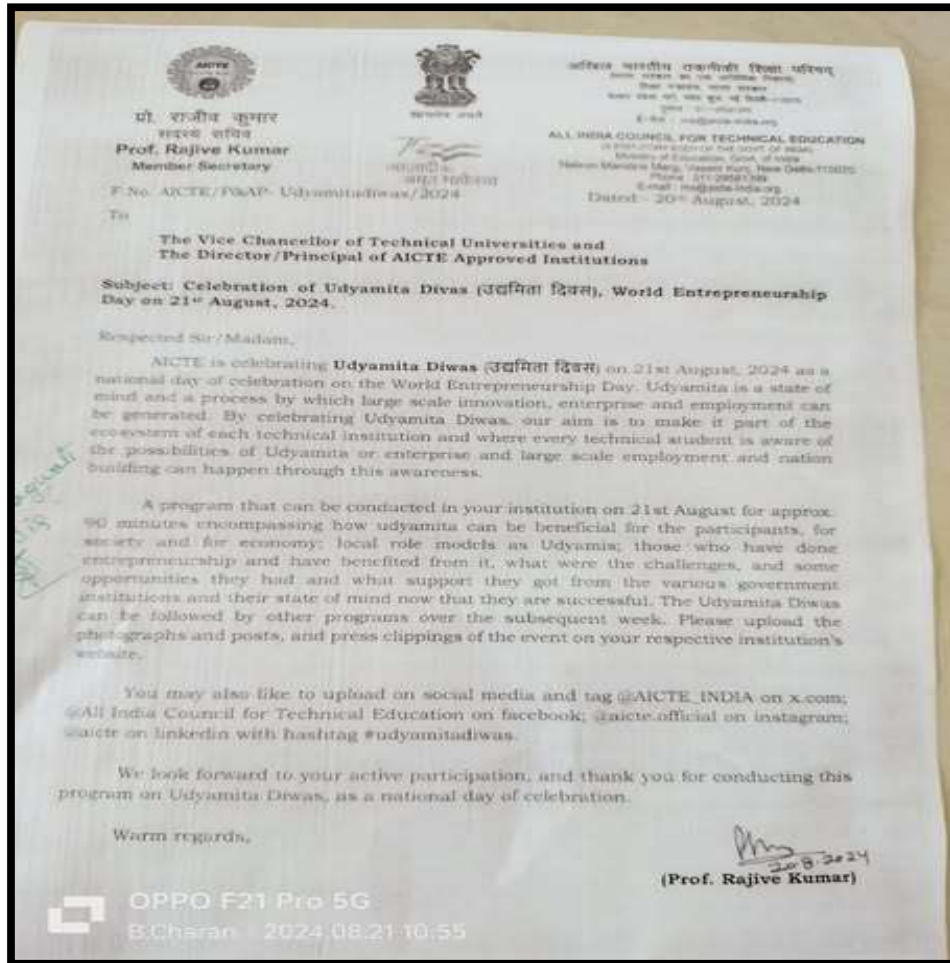

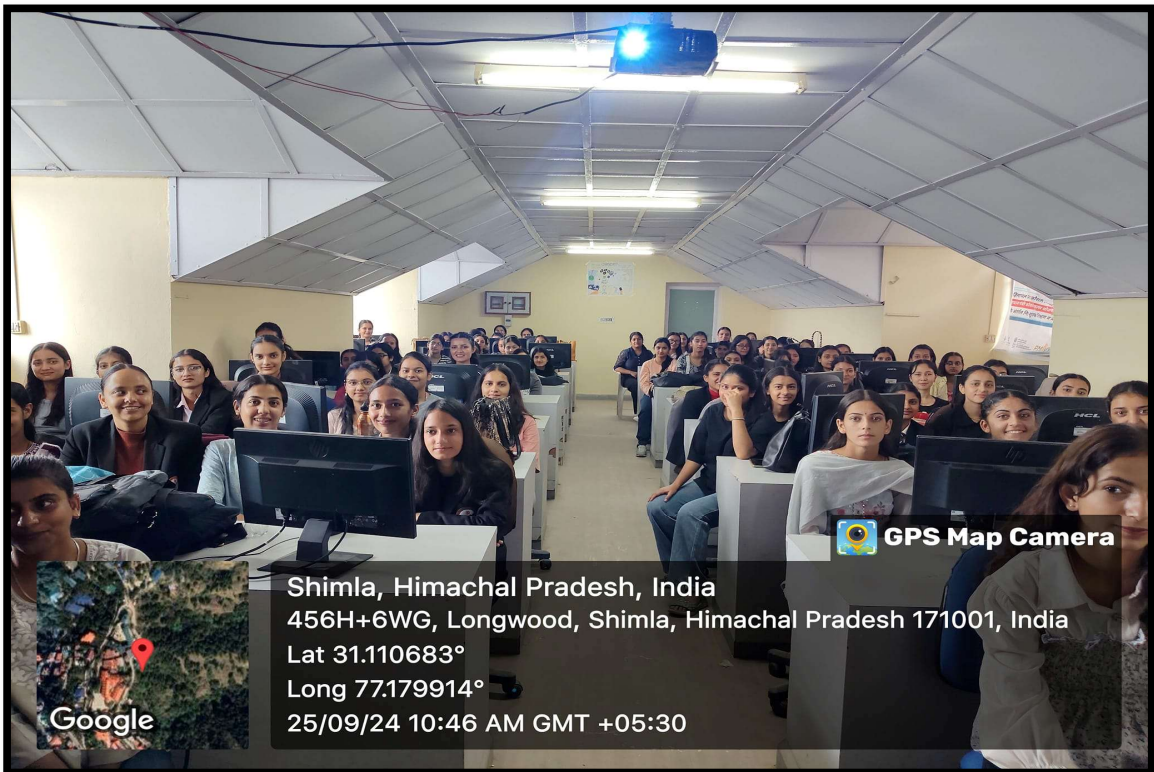
Certificates were distributed to all participants as a token of appreciation, and the event concluded with positive feedback from attendees, marking the success of the workshop.

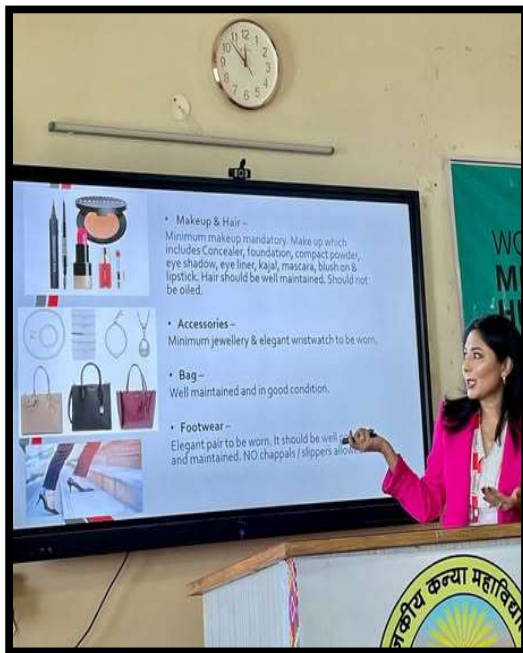

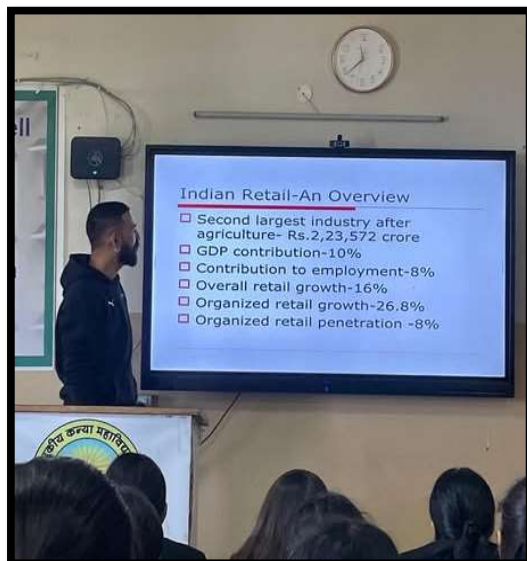

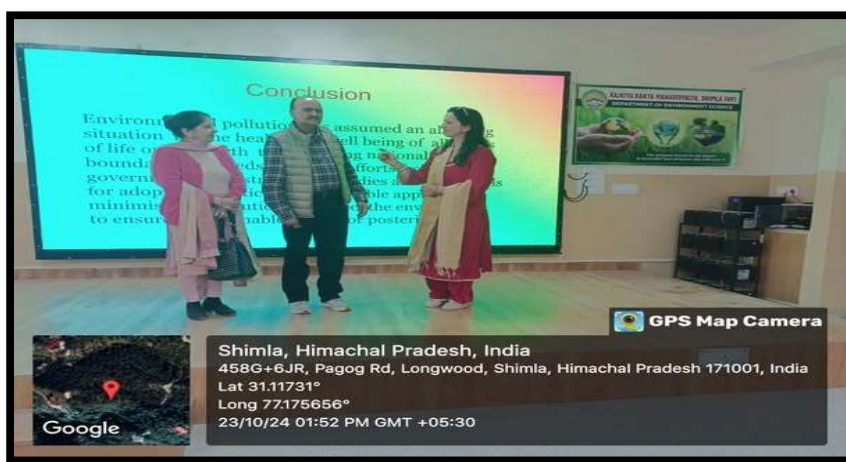


# The Department of Environmental Science

This celebration not only commemorated the adoption of the Constitution but also reinforced the responsibility of every citizen in preserving and protecting the values of democracy and justice.

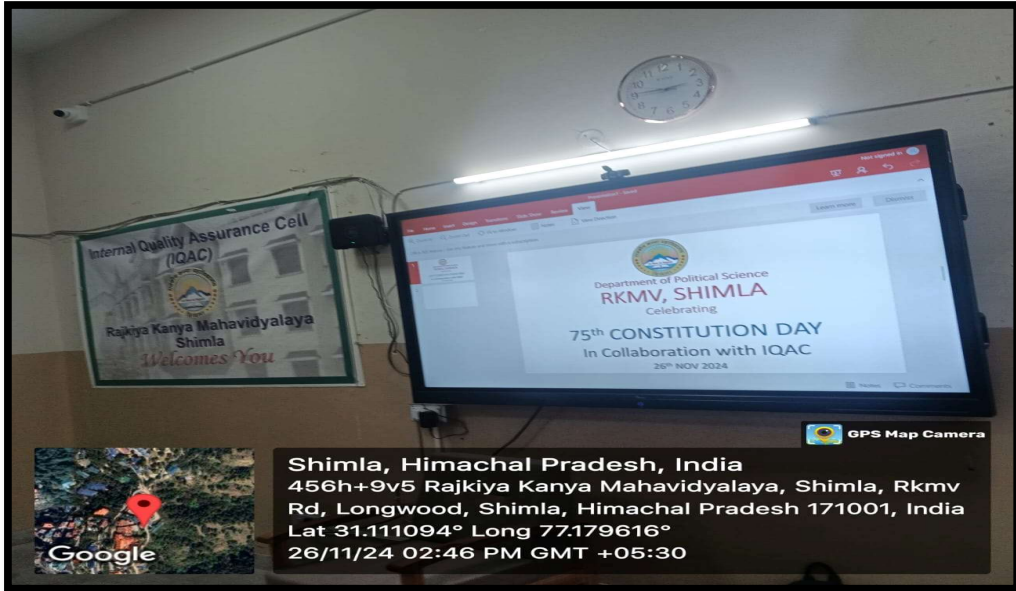
